"We have a new broom!" as Jaco Van As (chairperson for CPF Lyttelton) remarked at our recent Community meeting held on 9 September at the new Centurion Primary School in Blinkblaar avenue. We bid welcome to the new Station Commander, Brig TP Matlala.

He has served in SAPS for the past 25 years and have Station Commander now at 5 stations.

Brig. Matlala was very impressed by the attendance at our meeting, saying that the community is very important, being eyes and ears for SAPS.



Safety starts at home, every home owner being a station commander at his own home. If you don't take care of your home, no one else will.

The Brigadier challenged the community to report crime and be active, thereby also keeping SAPS active. "If we work together, we will be successful!"

Capt Guy Weilbach, our Sector Commander, shared the following:

1. At Centurion Mall all entrances/exits have LPR cameras. It is proving very successful,
2. Big malls in Gauteng is linked, info can be shared,
3. Armed robbery in Silverpine, lady with R30,000, she managed to drive away. We picked up the regno, arrests were made of guys who follow people from bank.
4. Foreigners from hotels are robbed in alleyways. New fencing was put up.
5. No Holding cells for the past 8 years. Hopefully this will change soon.
6. New Taxi rank will be finished by the end of 2019.
7. Home Affairs offices might be moving. The parking is a huge problem and vagrants are "managing" the queue, offering a chair in front at a price.
8. TMPD are issuing tickets for traffic violations.
9. The Lapswaaiers are also suspected to be involved in crime.
10. People standing begging: arrests have been made, fined, go to court, keep on. Ladies with children, Dept. of Social Development must be involved. The problem is that the Mother is a foreigner, but the child was born in South Africa. You can't split mother and child.

Lyttelton SAPS operational success: Car thief caught!

On 2019/08/13:

Members of the Lyttelton Roving team were on duty when they received information regarding a white VW Polo that was suspected to be used in theft out of motor vehicles in the Lyttelton policing area. The suspect vehicle was seen entering Dorinkloof suburb and the team immediately sprung into action and began to search for it.

The vehicle was spotted at Dorinkloof Primary school, there was one african male inside the vehicle, the members then tactically approached the suspect and searched the vehicle, inside they found two devices that are used to jam the remote locking mechanism of motor vehicles. They further found that the vehicle had false registration plates on and the original plates were hidden under the back seat.

The suspect was placed under arrest and will face charges of:

- 1) Possession of car breaking implements
- 2) Possession of suspected stolen property
- 3) Fraud.

The suspect will appear in the Pretoria magistrates court within 48 hrs.

The Management of Lyttelton SAPS under the Command of Brigadier TP Matlala has welcomed the arrest and praised the members for their hard work and dedication. He further said that "the South African Police Services would not allow the criminals to come into our areas and do what they want, we will do what is necessary in order to make sure that our streets are safe and free of the criminal element. "

How NOT to be a soft target

1. While walking, put your phone out of sight and be aware of people or vehicles around you,
2. When parking your vehicle, check by hand if all doors are locked properly,
3. When drawing cash, don't help anyone, if you suspect tampering, report,
4. **Don't draw large amounts of cash alone!**
5. Coming home, stop just inside your gate, until it is closed, with no room for a vehicle to box you in.
6. As soon as possible, lock your doors.
7. Keep curtains drawn when lights inside are on,
8. Beware of hoax sms's or emails, check before you react,
9. Stopping at a traffic light, make eye contact with the beggar, don't open your window, do not give him anything, because that is keeping him there!


