- The 17 Community Reported crimes reduced by 40,5% from 528 counts to 314 counts.

Contributing factors



- Daily influx of community as well as daily vehicle traffic – this also lead to delay of police response and efficiency - (main attractions include Centurion Mall and Irene Village)
- Area is close to various informal settlements that suspects use for hiding destinations, planning and offset points.
- Personal items left in parked vehicles (laptops, cash, wallets, cell phones, handbags and luggage)
- A lot of the streets serves as escape routes and criminals use public transport as means of transport



Recommendation



- Requests to community in assisting with combating crime:
 - ❖ Burglaries at residential premises & house robberies – the community needs to increase personal security at their residence.
 - ❖ Most of all the robberies suspects were armed with firearms followed by knives. Communities should not resist and enrage criminals, as this may lead to serious assaults and in some cases deaths.
 - ❖ Community should be vigilant and needs to be aware of his/her surroundings when driving especially to and from work and home. Lock your vehicle doors, secure and hide your property (e.g. handbags, cell phones) out of sight from pedestrians, this will also prevent smash and grabs.
 - ❖ Please report offences as soon as possible, do not delay reporting of crimes. All cases reported are being used by the SAPS to establish problem areas and for deployment of members and resources.
 - ❖ Evaluate and where possible upgrade security systems, gates and burglar proofing. (including vehicle alarm and security systems)
 - ❖ Report suspicious activities and people. Do not take the law into your own hands.
