Holiday Awareness 1 of 3

v	Don't delay, be prepared today	
1 Do:	Make sure your home looks occupied	
2 Do:	Make sure your home is well lit-up outside. Use day/night motion sensor globes outside	
3 Do:	Put your inside lights on automatic timers corresponding to your usual routine If you usually deviate from routine, then adjust timers accordingly	
4 Do:	Lock all outside doors, windows, also upstairs, garden sheds and garage doors	
5 Do:	Install deadbolts on all external doors, especially sliding doors	
6 Do:	Suspend all newspaper deliveries.	
7 Do:	If you have a scheduled pet food delivery, ensure your pet-sitter is available to receive it	
8 Do:	Ask pet sitter to let dogs sleep inside and check garden every morning for poison when they let Dogs out	
9 Do:	Ask your neighbour to remove all mail and advertisements from postbox or stuck onto gate.	
10 Do:	Ask your neighbour to cut your pavement lawn	
11 Do:	Check that your alarm is working properly and all batteries are replaced. Arm when you leave. Complete "CPF LS1 Confidential Away form".	
12 Do:	Clear any overhanging bushes/branches from your garden or hiding places	
13 Do:	Always make sure your gate is properly closed before driving off	
14 Do:	Lock away any spare remotes, car keys and house keys or leave them with your house-sitter Make sure your armed response has alternate contact details in case of an emergency

Holiday Awareness 2 of 3

✓	Don't delay, be prepared today	
15 Do:	Be aware of your surroundings when entering and exiting your property – take note of any cars that may be following you and rather drive past your home to a safe place and phone for help	
16 Do:	Know your neighbours and build a mutual trust relationship	
17 Do:	Join your local CPF and arm yourself with Crime Awareness	
18 Do:	Electric fence, motion detection beams and lights outside, CCTV cameras and Alarm system connected to armed response – these give you time to get help, in time	
1 Don't:	Leave valuables in plain sight or near windows	
2 Don't:	Leave items visible in the garden such as toys or equipment	
3 Don't:	Never leave keys hidden anywhere	
4 Don't:	Leave notes on door or gate, such as "gone – back in 5 mins"	
5 Don't:	Keep large amounts of cash at home and always store firearms in appropriate safe	
6 Don't:	Stop in your driveway to wait for the gate to open – park parallel to the driveway and slip in quickly once the gate is open, stop just inside aEnd close gate immediately	
7 Don't:	Don't post your holiday pics on social media until you are back safe	
8 Don't:	Don't leave your dustbin outside when you leave, ask neighbour or house-sitter to put out and bring in on dustbin day	
9 Don't:	Go outside at night if you hear a noise or for any other reason – get armed response to check
